James P. Muldoon Jr. (1959-2016) was an independent scholar of international affairs and a senior Fellow (non-residential) with the Center for Global Change and Governance of Rutgers University – Newark. His research and writing focused on multilateral diplomacy, international organizations and global governance. Affectionately known as Jim by his friends and family, Jim was the Vice-Chair of the Mosaic Institute's Board of Directors from 2013-2016. During this time, Jim played an integral role in the guidance, support and development of the organization. The James P. Muldoon Jr. Bursary Award honours both Jim and his wife Reeta Roy's dedication to creating a more just, equitable and harmonious world.

The James P. Muldoon Jr. Bursary Award is available to undergraduate students in Canada whose field of study is related to the mission of the Mosaic Institute: We are a 'think and do' tank that creates platforms for learning and dialogue among diverse Canadian communities to advance justice, promote peace, and reduce conflict. Members of the Institute, their relatives, and current UofMosaic Fellows are not eligible.
