  - Applicants in their final year are welcome to apply for the duration of the two-year Fellowship
  - UofMosaic alumni from 2017-2018 or earlier are welcome to apply
- ✓ Demonstrated commitment to conflict resolution, pluralism, and inclusion;
- ✓ Student leader who embodies the Candidate Profile of being a strategist, systems-thinker, changemaker, leader, and scholar;
- ✓ Energetic and creative, with experience leading students and the coordination of on-campus events; and
- ✓ Available and willing to commit to the entire Fellowship term (October 2019 – June 2021)
