
Navigating our self-directed course

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What can I expect my daily schedule to look like while taking this course?

A: Each day, participants should expect to watch one learning module, complete the supplementary material(s) provided & connect with educators on our community forum.

Q: How long is the course?

A: This course is designed to be completed in one day and includes 1.5 hours of video content, 4 quizzes, downloadable materials, and discussion boards. However, the course is asynchronous, which means learners can work at their own pace and can complete the certificate by October 1st, 2023.

Q: What does it mean to become a certified Next Gen Educator?

A: This course builds the capacity for educators to teach using a peace and justice framework. Being a certified Next Generation educator means you have strengthened your capacity to teach using these approaches. You will also have access to our Next Generation Educator Network monthly resources & educator-specific content upon course completion.

Q: Was this course created just for educators?

A: This course was created for classroom teachers (specifically secondary school teachers), as many of the modules and daily tasks include practical suggestions for instruction, assessment, pedagogical approaches, etc. Certain modules will address content that would be most relevant to the social sciences and humanities curriculum as well.
